- It is not mandatory, it is just a guide to narrow down options

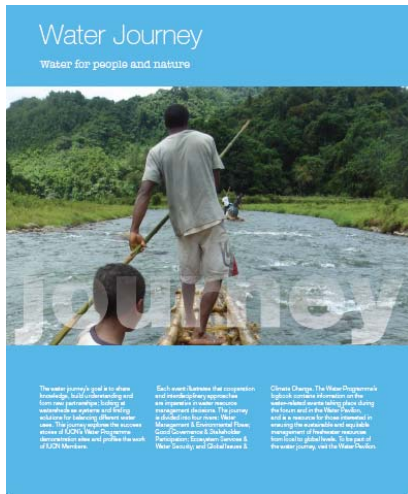


Water Journey – Rivers

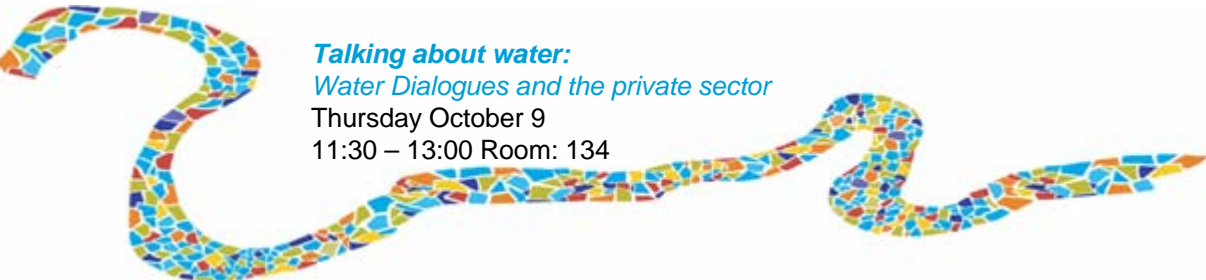
