Dr. Smrithi Talwar is a public international lawyer who has specialized in environmental policy pertaining to the decentralized and participatory governance of natural resources. She is currently employed with The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) in New Delhi as Chief Coordinator in the Director General's Office. Within TERI Dr. Talwar also leads a multi-disciplinary team of specialists who are engaged in designing and implementing a sustainable rehabilitation strategy for large-scale development project affected people in various parts of the country.

In addition to her work at TERI, Dr. Talwar lectures on Indian and international environmental law, focusing her talks on the governance implications of these laws.
