

Subscription and submission of abstract

Subscription to the conference is open until 31 of March 2010.

A participant who wants to give a presentation is requested to submit an abstract of the presentation between 20th December 2009 and 31 March 2010.

Due to limited possibilities of the venue, there is a maximum of 70 participants who can attend the conference. In case there are more subscriptions, a selection will be made based on the quality of the abstract, the number of participants from the region or country and the order of subscription.

The selection procedure will be executed by the organization committee, and will finalized by the end of April 2010.

The organization committee's decisions on the acceptance or rejection of abstracts will be communicated at the beginning of May 2010. The abstract can be accepted as an oral presentation or *poster* presentation.
